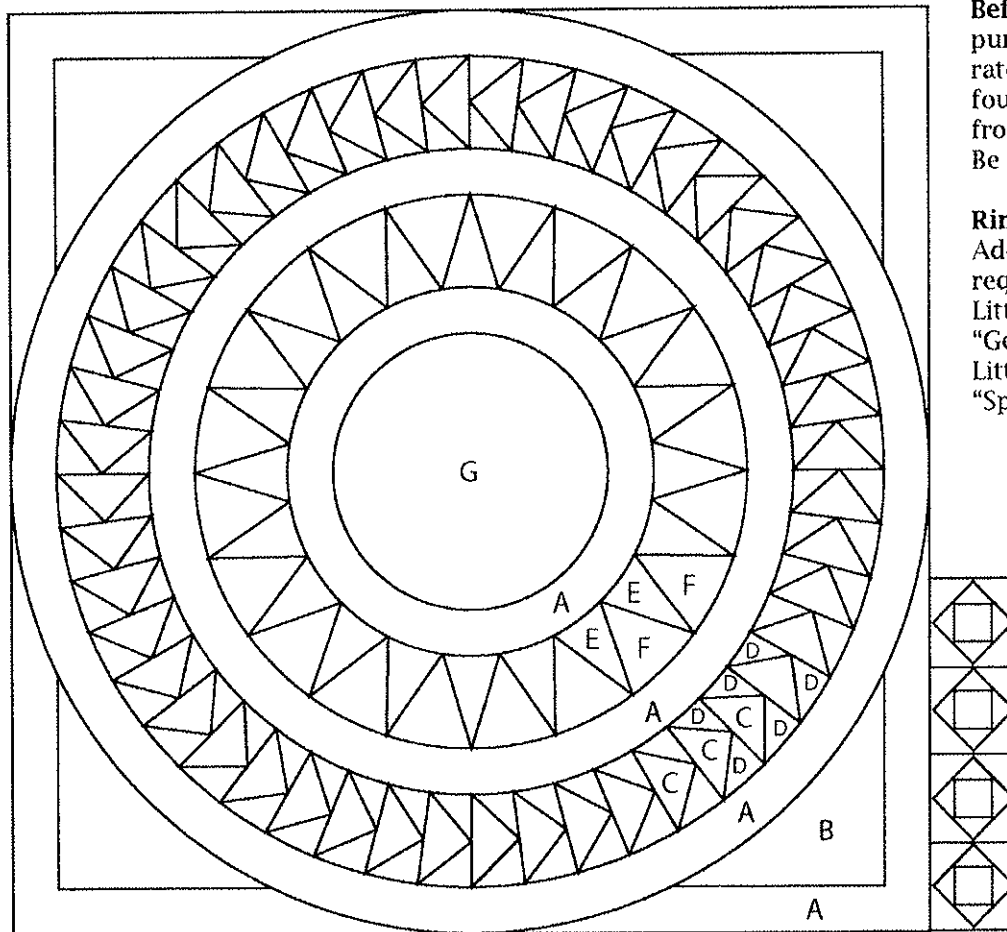


Cosmati rings I 1-Day Workshop

1-Day Workshop: This class teaches large-scale curved foundation piecing and features many tips and methods for saving time. Principles of curved seam piecing and sequencing for easier assembly are also a major part of the class. Machine applique for the corner sections and "doughnut hole" applique will be demonstrated. Optional center compass designs will be included should time permit, and compass patterns will be provided.



Before class: If *not* using purchased foundations, accurately trace at least enough foundations for 1/4 of quilt from the master pullout page. Be accurate!

Rings II variation

Add and change fabric requirements as follows:
 Little "geese": 3/8 yard
 "Geese background": 7/8 yard
 Little "spikes": 1/4 yard
 "Spikes" background: 7/8 yard

Supply List

- *Foundations for Cosmati Rings I
(packet includes 4 different designs)
- Freezer paper, 1 roll
- Sheet of fine sandpaper
- Fabric marking pencils
- Safety pins (about 12-20)
- Fine, sharp straight pins
- Paper scissors
- Fabric scissors
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Quilter's ruler, ("add-a-quarter" ruler, opt.)
- Glue stick
- Basting glue (like "Roxanne's")
- Thread (both cotton and "invisible")
- Sewing machine

Fabric Requirements

- A Bands: 2 yards
- B Corners (background): 3/8 yd.
- C "Geese": 1/2 yard
- D "Geese Background": 1/2 yard
- E "Spikes": 3/8 yard
- F "Spikes" background: 1/2 yard
- G Plain center circle: 13" square **or**
Center compasses: use scraps from other sections

Optional border of Diamond in a Square blocks:

- small inner squares: 1/4 yard
- Background square: 3/8 yard
- Quarter-square triangles: 1/2 yard
(2 colors, 1/4 yard each)
- Band: 1/2 yard
